



## Bypass Restrictions by State

If a driver receives a green light, and any of the following conditions apply, the driver must pull into the inspection facility.

### Alabama

**Oversize/Overweight** (even permitted loads)

Agricultural loads

Bulk fuel loads

Livestock loads

### Arizona

**Oversize/Overweight** (unless Class E permit)

Fuel import loads

Placarded Hazmat and Hazwaste loads

### Arkansas

**Oversize/Overweight** (even permitted loads)

Placarded Hazmat and Hazwaste loads

### California

**Oversize/Overweight** (even permitted loads)

Agricultural loads – only pull in if directed by enforcement facility signs

Vehicles using multiple bypass systems: If you receive a red light for either system, you are not permitted to bypass.

### Colorado

**Oversize/Overweight** (even permitted loads) **except LCVs operating with an annual permit and receive a green light**

Temporary permit to haul hazardous waste/materials

### Delaware

**Oversize/Overweight** (even permitted loads)

### Florida

**Oversize/Overweight** (even permitted loads)

#### Florida Agricultural Inspection Facilities

(Yulee I-95, White Springs I-75, Live Oak I-10, Pensacola I-10)

Approved Carriers: Agricultural loads

Non-Approved Carriers: **ANY LOAD**

### Illinois

**Oversize/Overweight** (even permitted loads)

### Indiana

**Oversize/Overweight** (even permitted loads)

### Iowa

**Oversize/Overweight** (even permitted loads)

### Kansas

**Oversize/Overweight** (even permitted loads) except LCVs operating with a KTA permit – South Haven Site only

### Kentucky

**Oversize/Overweight Single Trip Permits**

### Louisiana

**Oversize/Overweight** (even permitted loads)

### Michigan

**Oversize/Overweight** (even permitted loads)

### Mississippi

**Oversize/Overweight** (even permitted loads)

Private carriers transporting taxable petroleum products

### Missouri

**Oversize/Overweight** (even permitted loads)

### Montana

**Overweight** (even permitted loads)

**Oversize (except when operating on a valid over-dimensional permit with any of the following conditions along with a green light)**

Overwidth at 10 feet or less

Overheight at 15 feet 6 inches or less

Overlength with a term 95 feet doubles permit

### Nebraska

**Oversize/Overweight** (even permitted loads)

Vehicles using multiple bypass systems: If you receive a red light for either system, you are not permitted to bypass.

**Oversize/Overweight** (even permitted loads)

**Oversize/overweight** (even permitted loads) **except RS permitted trucks weighing up to 98,000 lbs. on 6 axles at the Superior NB and SB SWEF only**

### Wyoming

**Oversize/Overweight** (even permitted loads)

Livestock loads
